What to Bring

- Non skid, non marking shoes
- Waterproofs and warm cloth. Summer cloth in summer.
- Sleeping bag and a Towel



What not to Bring

- Hard luggage. Please bring only sailing bags or soft holdalls. No hard or wheeled luggage can be allowed on the boat.
- Life Jackets. These are provided for you on the boat.

We provide

- Food and drinks during the course (breakfast and small lunch)
- All boat expenses for operate the boat.

What to Expect

A mixture of classroom and practical sessions covering a variety of topics. You will be asked to prepare a subject to preens to the class. Please bring with you any training aids you may wish to use. Laptop, iPad, model boat etc. You will have use of our classroom.
