THESSALIA SAILING FAQs

Do we have to share a cabin?

Everyone on our boat is guaranteed their own cabin.

You will never be asked to share with a complete stranger.

What is included in the price?

Breakfast, lunch and 3 evening meals on the boat.

Linen, fuel and mooring fees.

What is not included in the price?

The cost of getting here.

Meals eaten out in tavernas

What is the minimum age:

The minimum age for all courses is 18 for unaccompanied students.

For Competent Crew courses, the minimum age is 14 for students unaccompanied by a guardian.

For Day Skipper courses, the minimum age is 16 for students accompanied by a guardian.

When do the courses start and finish?

You arrive in Volos on Saturday. The boat is ready to board at 1530.

The course begins on Sunday morning at 0900.

The course end in Volos at 1700 on Thursday.

In the case of the mile builders, we leave Volos on Saturday when everyone is aboard and return to Volos on Friday at 1700.

Do we stay on the boat all week:

Yes, you stay on the boat all week and can stay on the boat on Thursday evening in Volos ready to travel home on Friday.

What do we need to bring?

Once you book the course, you will receive your joining instructions which will answer all your questions about clothing etc.

Where do we go during the course?

Our training ground is the south of the gulf of Volos and across to Evia.

We stay in a different location every night, either a small fishing harbour eating in a taverna, or at anchor in a secluded bay, eating aboard.

For the Mile Builder, we head out into the North Aegean and cover 50/60 mile passages every day.

What is the boat?

The school boat is a Dufour 45 Classic, with 3 double cabins and a double bunk cabin.
